



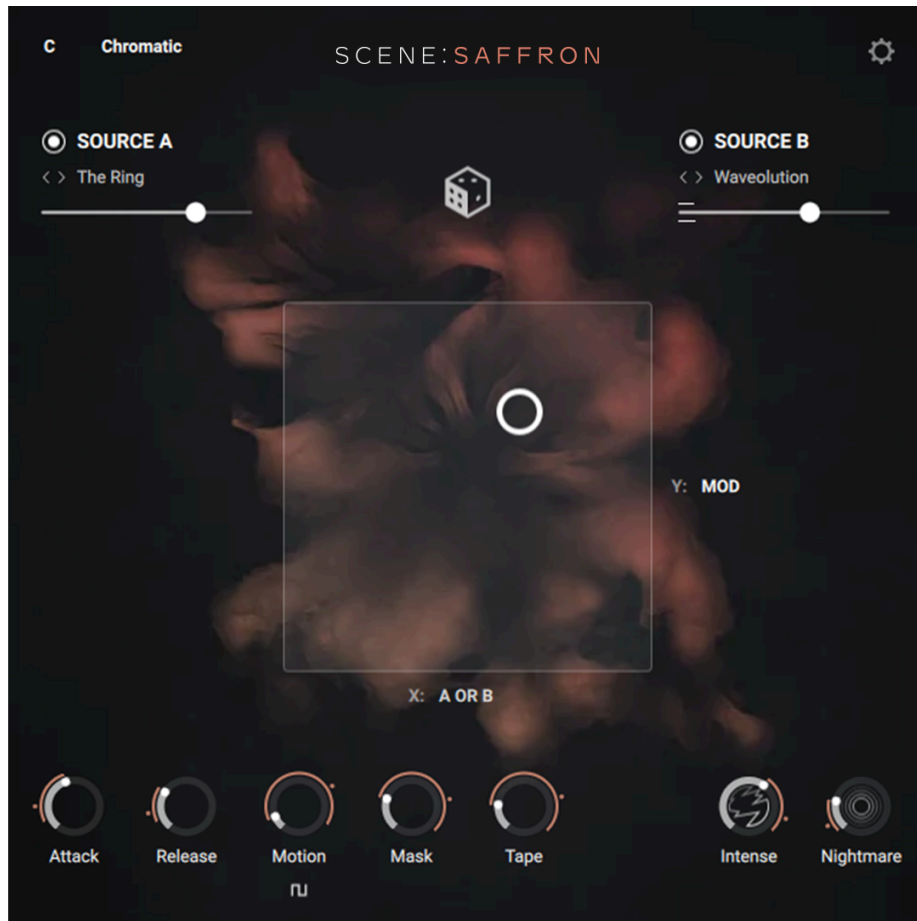
## **Native Instruments reveals a lightweight new cinematic instrument for composers, Scene: Saffron**

*The first entry in the new Scene Series promises blendable cinematic textures for creative world-building with sound.*



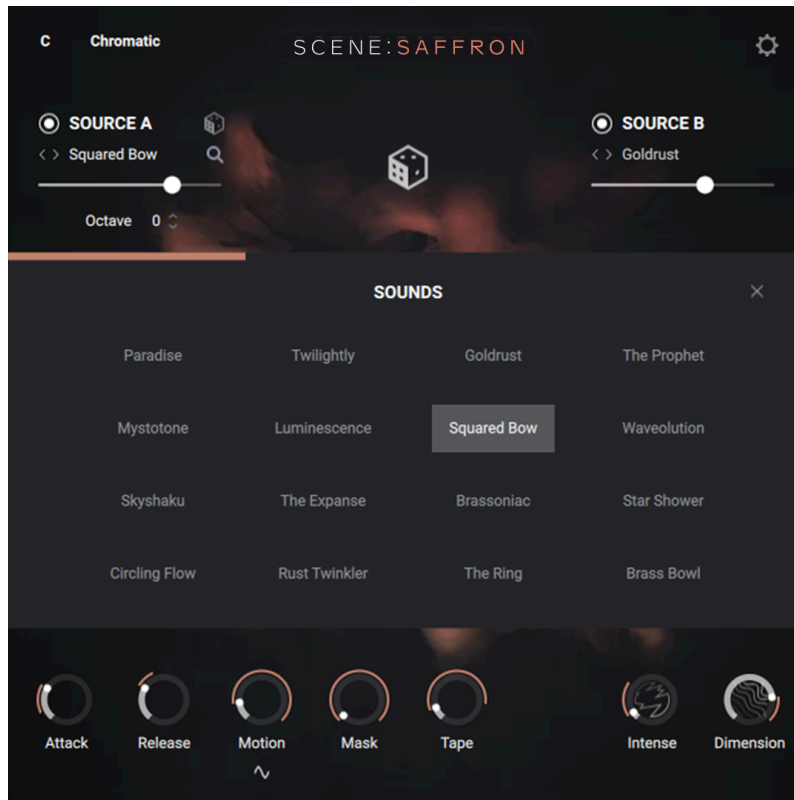
